

DISCOVER Abama

On the southwest coast of Tenerife, 30 minutes from the international airport with stunning views of the isle of La Gomera, lies the 5* resort of Abama.

An award-winning residential, golf and leisure resort set across 400 luxuriantly landscaped hectares, Abama's microclimate enjoys an average temperature of 21°C and warm winds of the Azores, making it the perfect golf destination all year round.

Abama is set across 400 beautifully landscaped hectares and home to a rolling, par 72, 18-hole golf course featuring over 25,000 palm trees, white-sand bunkers and dozens of lakes connected by waterfalls.

Acclaimed as one of the finest in Spain, the Dave Thomas-designed course has been crafted to test and surprise all golfers, no matter their level of expertise. In October, Tenerife is set to host the World Corporate Golf Challenge for the second year running, and the Sports Legends Cup will take place at Abama on the 4th and 5th October, attended by some of the most renowned names in European sport.

However, golf isn't the only pastime to enjoy at Abama. Players and their

families can make the most of the private sandy beach, Kids' Club, four padel courts and seven tennis courts, which are frequented by both the ATP and ITF tours. At the Quarterly 'Wellness Weekends', guests can enjoy a curated timetable of sports, treatments and therapies designed to nourish the soul and re-charge the batteries.

This year, Abama unveiled 'La Plaza', a €14 million lifestyle quarter offering shopping, dining, fitness and relaxation areas for residents and hotel guests. The first phase includes a beautiful infinity pool with views over the resort and ocean, a new restaurant 'Tagara' and social club, ideal for relaxing during the day or enjoying an evening sun-downer with tapas. Future phases of La Plaza will include a full fitness centre, further dining and retail offerings, a gourmet deli, spa with treatment rooms and salon.

More widely, Abama is home to some of Tenerife's best cuisine – its restaurants claim three of the island's six Michelin stars. These include Tenerife's only two-star restaurant 'M.B' and the one-starred 'Kabuki', located in the resort's Ritz Carlton hotel. As well as fine dining, award-winning golf course and wellness facilities, Abama also offers a mix of luxury residential properties and



serviced holiday accommodation. Residents enjoy access to the resort's extensive facilities, with the benefit of being able to organise PT or yoga sessions with the resort's resident instructors, in their private villas.

Adjacent to the resort's tennis centre, Las Villas del Tennis is a limited collection of 23 detached homes designed by local architects Virgilio Gutiérrez Herreros and Eustaquio Martínez. Nestled in lush vegetation on generous 430 sq.m - 694 sq.m plots, these homes feature beautifully landscaped gardens, pools and outdoor seating, ideal for soaking up the panoramic views of the Atlantic and the golf course. Each home is delivered fully interior

designed including outdoor furniture, and offers the utmost privacy and convenience for family and guests. Each home also offers covered or underground parking.

Residents also gain automatic membership to the Abama Prestige Owners' Club which offers a range of specially curated events and cultural excursions, alongside the resort's Property Management programme, which oversees the rental and property maintenance of each home. Three-bedroom villas are priced from €1.875million.

As this unique resort develops, Abama has implemented extensive sustainable policies, from water conservation, to energy conservation through the

implementation of solar panels and waste recycling. Already BREEAM and EMAS certified, each new architect commissioned at Abama is selected based on their commitment to green technology, their use of local labour and materials, and pledge to reduce their impact on the natural landscape.

The fully furnished homes of Los Jardines are some of the most sustainable on the island, fitted with energy-saving technologies and international brands such as Porcelanosa, Axor-Hansgrohe, and Duravit. One to three-bedrooms, these residences are the epitome of hassle-free island living, starting from €875,000.

Beyond the resort, the island of

Tenerife has much to offer from guided walks up the Teide Volcano – the highest peak in Spain – to whale and dolphin watching, windsurfing, paragliding and star gazing.
